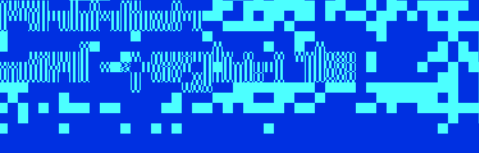
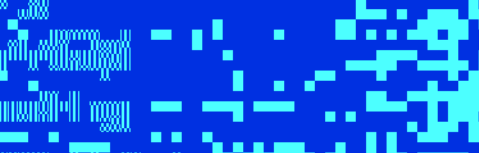
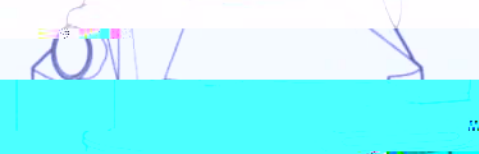

Grounding Instructions

This appliance must be grounded. If it should malfunction or break down, a properly grounded outlet box cover, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This appliance is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and grounding plug. The plug must be inserted into an appropriate outlet that is properly grounded and marked with the grounding symbol.

NOTE: In Canada, the use of a temporary adaptor is not permitted by the Canadian Electrical Code.

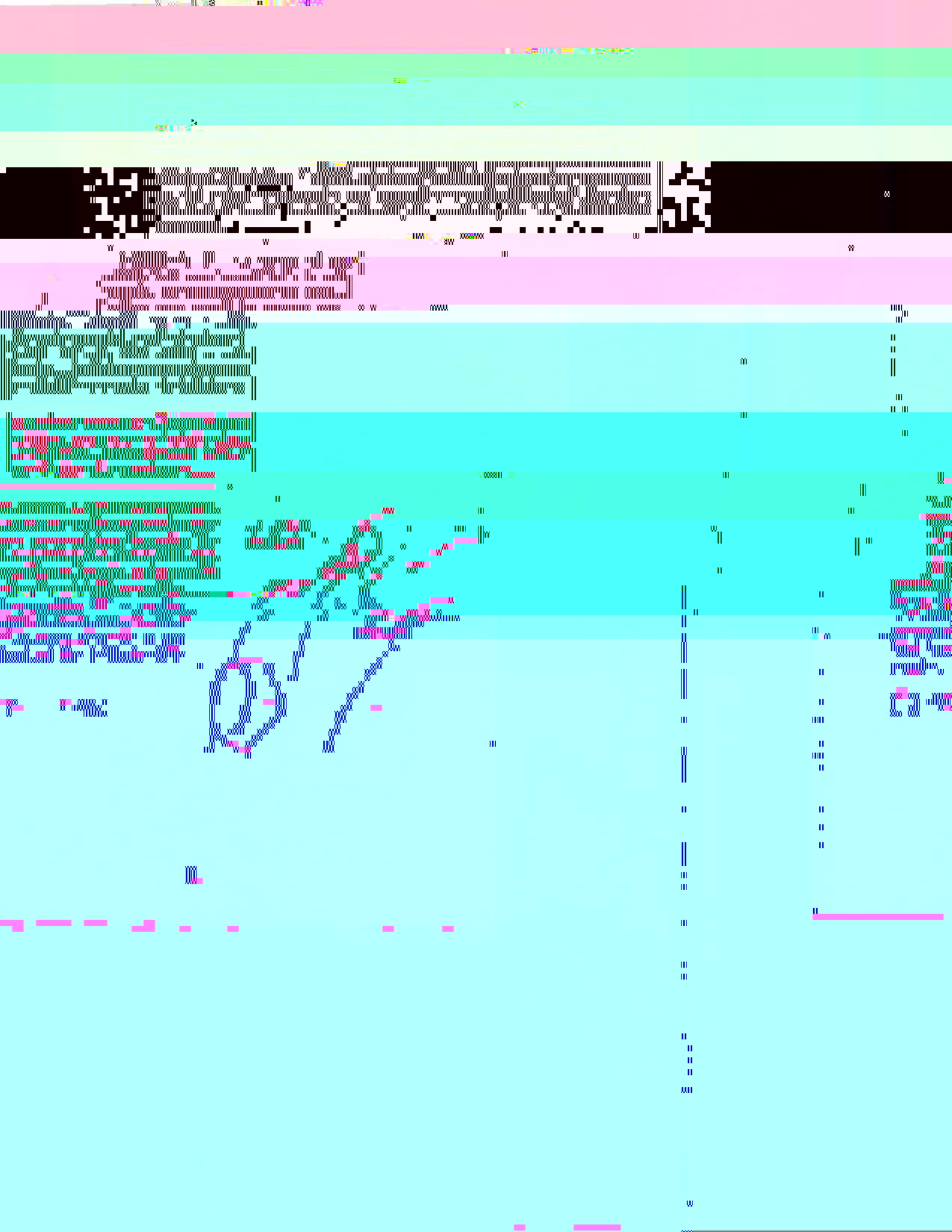

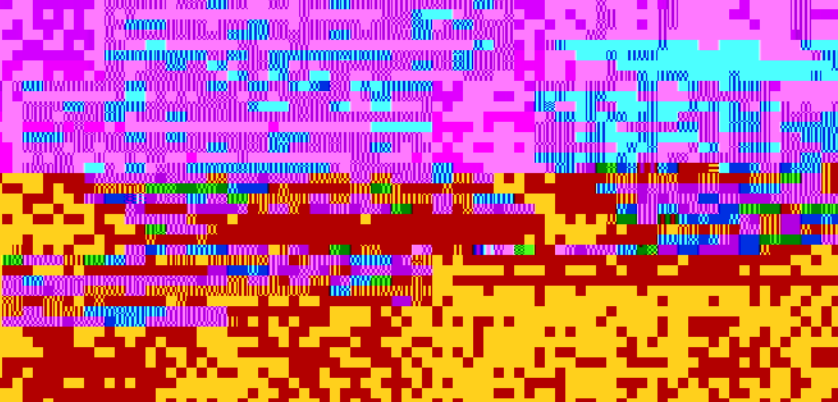
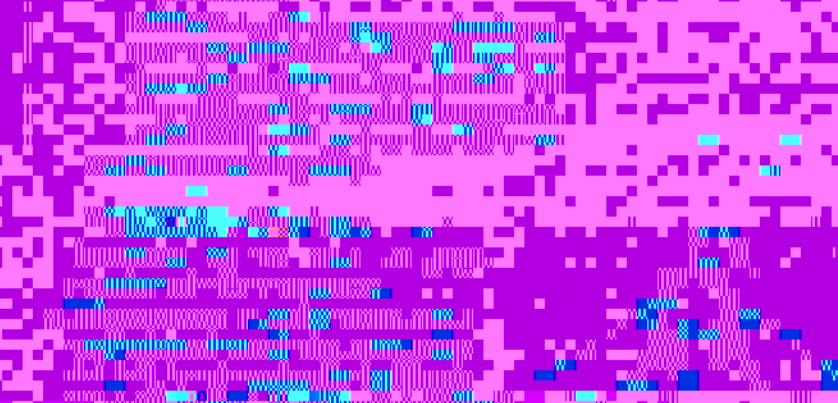

1. The filter must always be in the correct position to reduce the risk of spillage and possible damage to vac. Make sure that the filter is completely covering the filter cage and that the retainer band is as



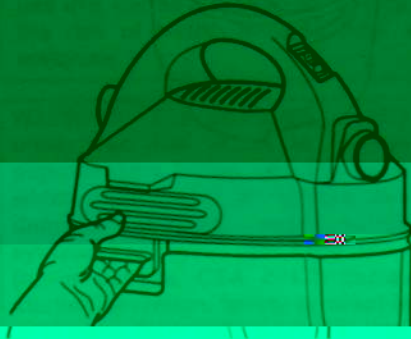
Operation (continued)

Emptying the Drum

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury from accidental starting, unplug power cord before emptying the drum.

1. Remove the power head assembly of the wet/dry vac by pulling outward on the latches located on each side of the vac. Lift off the power head assembly.

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury from accidentally starting the vacuum cleaner, always disconnect the power cord before cleaning filter.

IMPORTANT: To avoid damage to the blower wheel and motor, always reinstall the filter before using the vac for dry cleaning.
