REQUIREMENTS FOR HISTORY MAJORS AS OF FALL 2017

Thirty-three credits. These must include one course at the introductory level (select from HST 009 through HST 068), one History Methods course (101), plus fifteen additional credits at the intermediate level (100), and three credits at the advanced level (200). These thirty-three credits must also include fifteen credits of concentration in one of the departments' three areas of study (The Americas; Europe; Africa/Asia/Middle East/Global) and six credits in each of the others. The fifteen-hour concentration must include one course at the intermediate level and one seminree s
