The Association of American Medical Deges (AAMC) recommends that all US medical schools procure a nationable ground check on applicants upon their conditional acceptance to medical schoole Tationale for performing criminal background checks on accepted medical schoolicapts is based on a number of issues, including the need to enhage the safety and well-being of patients and, in so doing, to bolster the public's continuing trust in the dimental profession, and tescertain the ability of accepted applicants to evently abecome licensed physicians.

The AAMC has initiated an AMCAS-factilited national background check service, through which Certiphi Screening, Inc. Vertical Screen® Compny) will procure a national background report on early decision gram applicants at the point of acceptance and all other applicants alphoiet of acceptance after January 1st. In addition, beginning in May of each yeam ational background reportil be procured for a subset of applicants who are on the point of acceptance. The AAMC has initiated this service in other to recognize the design medical schools to procure appropriate national criminal history reports to prevent applicants from paying additional fees at each medical school to which they are accepted.

During the AMCAS 2010 application year, paip ating medical schools may continue to require applicants to undergo a separateonatibackground check press, if required to do so by their own institutional regulations by applicable state law. Many medical schools not participating may also require plicants to undergo a separate national background check process.
