BME Specializat on Elect ve 1, 2, 3: Any 3 credits in BCOR, BHSC, BIOC, BIOL, BME, CEE, CEMS, CHEM, CMPE, COMU, CS, EE, EMGT, ENGR, ENSC, EXSC, HLTH, HSCI, MATH, ME, MLS, MMG, NSCI, PHRM, PHYS, RADT, or STAT. The number corresponds to the level at which the course must be taken (1000, 2000, 3000). Other courses may be approved by the BME Undergraduate Program Director.

_____ Students may take courses that fulf II more than one Catamount Core requirement, but they must st II take at least 40 unique credits of courses that have been approved to fulf II Catamount Core requirements.
