WORKING STEER HEALTH REQUIREMENTS*

You and your veterinarian should fill out the Cattle Health Form for 4-H Livestock or a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI). A licensed veterinarian certifying that the animal is clinically free of all infectious or contagious diseases and exposure from such diseases should sign this form. You will need to have this form with you at all 4-H shows, and your approval, lease/loan, and registration papers. If you are chosen to participate at Eastern States Exposition, all cattle must have a *CVI* (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) issued within 30 days of the event.

Note: All animals over 6 months must be castrated.
