



ROOM SET OPTIONS IN THE DAVIS CENTER

BANQUET STYLE

Round tables with chairs all the way around the tables

BOARDROOM STYLE

Rectangular tables pushed together in a solid rectangle with chairs around the perimeter

CIRCLE OF CHAIRS

Circle of chairs with an open center

CLASSROOM STYLE

Rectangular tables pushed together with chairs on one side facing the front of the room

CRESCENT ROUNDS

Round tables with chairs on one side facing the front of the room

WORKSHOP

Rectangular tables with chairs on two sides

HOLLOW RECTANGLE

Rectangular tables pushed together into a square or rectangle so that the center is open, chairs all the way around.

HORSESHOE

Rectangular tables pushed together with an opening at one end, chairs around the table perimeter. The horseshoe opens up to the front of the room for projector screen visibility.

LECTURE STYLE

Chairs in rows (with or without an aisle) facing the front of the room

EMPTY/RECEPTION STYLE

The room has no or minimal furniture in it
