

TREE FRUIT COMMODITY SURVEY

Conduct moth trapping surveys at 10 sites in 7 counties. Three of the sites also included stone fruit. Set one trap per site for each arthropod pest species listed below. Two traps were set in orchards where apples and stone fruit were present.

- o Variegated Golden Tortrix Moth (*Achips xylosteana*) at apple and stone fruit
- o Cherry Bark Tortrix (*Erasmia formosana*) at apple and stone fruit
- o Light Brown Apple Moth (*Epiphyas postvittana*) at apple and stone fruit
- o Summer Fruit Tortrix Moth () apple and stone fruit
- o Plum Fruit Moth (*Grapholita funebrana*) at stone fruit
- o European Cherry Fruit Fly (*Rhagoletis cerasi*) at stone fruit

Counties included Addison, Bennington, Chittenden, Grand Isle
