x Residential staff believes that a student may be missing based upon absence from University Housing or other information received by staff.

While an unexplainable absence of more than 24 hours gives rise to heightened concern, a student may be determined to be missing even if the student has been absent for a period of less than 24 hours

Missing StuderContact: The person, designated by the Missing Student, while be notified in the event a residential student is ever determined to be a Missing Student.
