- D. Present their approved 4-H Equine Identification/Approval form when entering 4-H Equine classes or 4-H events.
- E. Proof of rabies vaccine and negative Coggins from current year must be shown before unloading the animal(s) at all 4-H sponsored events.

- 3. No more than two unrelated youth may lease/loan the same animal for showing, exhibiting, or competing.
