The following table organizes some of the top sites for listing farm stays into three categories: General, Niche, and Travel Subscription. Sites in the General category tend to require more amenities to list and draw from a wider crowd. The Niche sites offer listings that range from a space to set up a tent to a fully equipped yurt to a stay in a local farmhouse; these sites tend to attract people looking for more of an experience. The Travel Subscription sites offer a free subscription/membership to their site in exchange for listing
